GENERAL INFORMATION

GC-3° is a combination of natural oils and extracts that may be used on most agricultural crops. When applied in accordance with the label, **GC-3**° can assist plants when they are under disease pressure, in the field and in the greenhouse conditions.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Continuous agitation while spraying is necessary for even distribution of the oil

FRUIT TREES AND VEGETABLES:

For best results, apply **GC-3**° before first signs of disease pressure or shortly there after. **GC-3**° can be easily incorporated into any IPM program.

Use 10 - 15 ml. of GC-3° per Litre of water or, 1 - 1.5 L of GC-3° per 100 Litres of water. Do NOT exceed 20ml. per Litre of water. Apply enough solution to cover the entire surface area of the infected tissue. Make repeat applications every 7-10 days while disease pressure is present. The use of spreader (Natural Wet*) may increase efficiency.

GARDEN PLANTS AND ORNAMENTALS:

Dilute 10 - 15 ml. of GC-3° per Litre of water. Do NOT exceed 20ml. per Litre of water. Use high pressure, high volume application equipment and thoroughly wet the foliage to the point of runoff. Make repeat applications every 7-10 days while disease pressure is present.

FIRST AID MEASURES

If contact occurs, immediately flush eyes with plenty of clean water for at least fifteen (15) minutes. Wash skin with soap and water and remove contaminated clothing.

If swallowed, drink large quantities of water immediately. Consult physician if irritation persists.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls.
